

International Student Training Course September 22 – 26, 2010 Frequently Asked Questions

How can I apply?

Only applications in written form can be accepted. Please use the official application form which can be found at www.mff-online.de or which can be requested at anmeldung@mff-online.de and fax it together with your matriculation certificate to +49 2131 2012 222 or by e-mail to anmeldung@mff-online.de. Only forms, which have been completely filled out, can be accepted. The places will be distributed according to the order of the reception of the applications. Every accepted application will be confirmed in writing as soon as possible. (Communication is preferably by e-mail.)

Who can apply?

Permitted are all students of the clinical semesters. Inscription only with valid matriculation certificate, showing in which year of the student program they are. Students, who apply for the first time, have priority over students, who already participated in a MFF Student Training Course. Maximum 80 participants (max. 5 students per university) will be accepted.

What are the costs?

The participation fee for the training is 249,- EUR (incl. VAT). Included are

- lectures,
- hands-on workshops,
- accomodation (4 nights),
- meals and drinks,
- visit to the Oktoberfest in Munich (transportation and food at private tables are included),
- party.

The journey has to be organized and paid by the participant. Together with your confirmation of participation you will receive an invoice, which has to be paid in advance to the following bank account:

The easiest way to reach Seebruck in Southern Germany (near to the Austrian border) is by car. The nearest airports are Salzburg/Austria (approx. 60 min by public transportation) and Munich/Germany (approx. 90 min by public transportation). If you travel with public transportation, please take the train to Bad Endorf. From there you reach Seebruck by taxi for about 15 EUR to 20 EUR.
